In recent days, I have been reminded of the difference we've made in the lives of so many mothers and in the battle we are still up against. Personally, I have been serving pregnant mothers in need since 2003 and I want to share with you some of my recent encounters.

While at a local restaurant, the employee stopped us to say how thankful she was for my help through her crisis pregnancy in 2008. She said her daughter is now 11 years old and wouldn't be here today if she hadn't received the support she needed at that time. This was such a beautiful moment for me personally to reflect on all the lives that God has allowed me to be part of over these years. It was also an encouragement for a recent mom to hear from this mom how God really does provide and how being a single mom is difficult, but entirely possible! Our experience seeing this mom at the restaurant gives me a lot of hope.

Recently, two Little Flower graduate moms reached out to us. Both moms are married to men who have answered God's call to be a husband and a father. Having an intact family is a healthy start, but many challenges are still arising for these two families. Both mothers are in quite a serious crisis. They are battling demons of addiction, physical health challenges and some very serious mental health issues. These two mothers have both requested our prayers for themselves and their families. It is a reminder that there is a spiritual battle going on around us and God is the only one who can help us! That we can not fight our addictions on our own strength. We need the love and mercy of God to help us. The most powerful thing we can do for each other is to pray for one another. 
